Certifications and approvals of our single-use breathalyzer



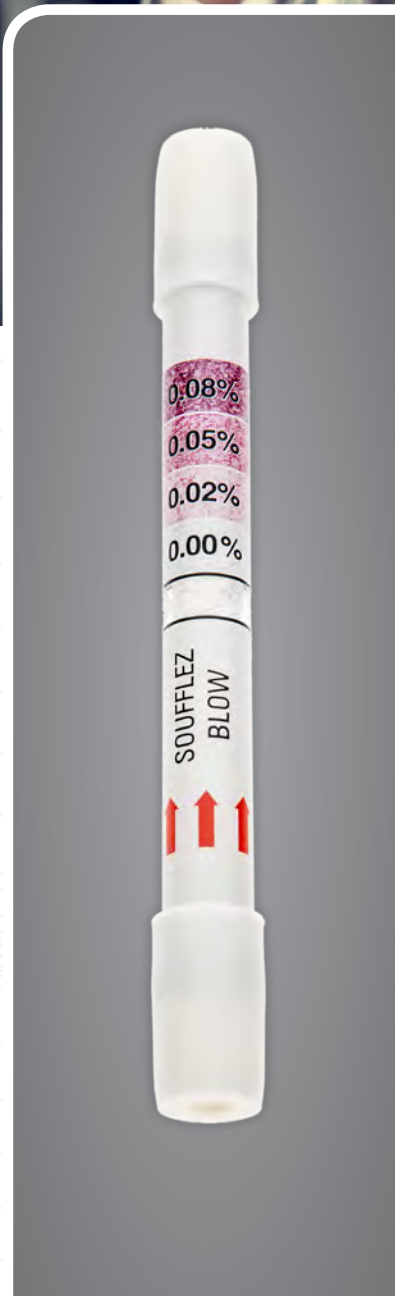

Our Alcograd Single-Use Breathalyzer meets the standards of internationally recognized organizations. These organizations follow strict scientific protocols.

These are the **European standard NF X 20-702** and the **TÜV Certification**. Few products meet these standards.

The Alcograd has also obtained **FDA certification**. In addition, this breathalyzer has been approved by **MADD Canada**.

You will find on the back a summary of the standards, certifications and approvals descriptions obtained by our Alcograd breathalyzer which demonstrates its reliability.



1) Standard NF – Description

The French **NF X 20-702** standard applies to single-use breathalyzers used as self-checking devices by the general public, companies and prevention associations. Several parameters are evaluated such as reliability, acceptable fault level, calibration, operation at different temperatures, etc.

- **Our Alcograd has met the NF standard.**

2) TÜV Certification. It is a European (German) certification body of recognized quality, present in 69 countries.

- This certification is a mark of high quality and respected worldwide.

3) FDA Certification (Food and Drug Administration) in North America.

- A very difficult certification to obtain.

4) Approval of MADD Canada (Mothers against drunk driving)

MADD Canada is a charitable organization whose mission is to stop impaired driving and to support victims of this violent crime.

MADD Canada recognizes that our breathalyzers "educate the public on the effects of alcohol consumption and provide an individual's current blood alcohol levels so they can make the right choice and not drive or boat impaired."

As demonstrated above, the Alcograd is a reliable tool that has met the most stringent industry standards for alcohol breath testers.

In addition, the latest SAAQ * (Société de l'assurance automobile du Québec) statistics inform us that:

Each year, alcohol-related injuries cause on average:

- 160 deaths - 370 seriously injured - 1,900 lightly injured

In 2013, 41% of drivers who died on the road had been drinking alcohol. The cost of compensating victims of drinking and driving is estimated at \$ 90 million a year.
